Beginner

Suited for those who have only recently taken up knitting and/or crocheting. In this workshop you'll learn basic techniques like knit and purl stitches for knitters, and chain, double and treble stitches for crocheters.



Intermediate

Suited for those who have some experience with knitting and crocheting. Knitters know how to cast on and off, increase and decrease, read a simple pattern and change colours in a knitting project. Crocheters know how to do single crochet and double treble stitches, read a simple pattern/diagram and change colours in a project.



Advanced

Suited for those who have completed multiple knitting or crocheting projects. Knitters have mastered several techniques, such as basic edge, cable, colour work and circular knitting, are acquainted with shaping a knitting project and have also used English-language patterns before. Crocheters at this level have mastered several basic techniques, such as Tunisian, mochila and filet crocheting, are able to crochet circles and rectangles and have also used English-language patterns before.



Highly advanced

Suited for those who have completed a wide variety of knitting or crocheting projects. Reading English-language patterns is no problem and you can reproduce most patterns you see. If you haven't got the ready knowledge to carry out a specific knitting or crocheting project, you can do so by looking up information about the techniques on your own. You have knitted or crocheted custom projects before.
